from Moscow to China through Orenburg – 4 422 km through Zabaikalsk – 6 641 km





More than 600 thousand trucks pass through the Orenburg region of the Russian-Kazakh border annually




The Orenburg region on the map of Russia

Agricultural land's area

The Orenburg region takes the **3rd place** in Russia in terms of agricultural land's area, which provides the **1st place** for the gathering of hard wheat, melons and gourds, as well as the **4th place** for the gathering of sunflowers. The Orenburg region is also takes the **8th place** for cattle population among Russian regions (**543 th. heads**)

The oil and gas is the basis of the raw materials economy in Russia. 4 % of **Russian oil and 2% of Russian gas are** producing in the Orenburg region. Orenburg gas and helium processing plants are the largest gas chemical complex in Europe








Processing of livestock products




Total meat production in live weight basis






